Helene's Ramble 32 bar jig for a 3 couple set, from "Step	pping Out" Part 2, by Marilyn

1-8	Six hands round and back	
9 -16	1 st couple lead down the middle and up, finish at corners, 2 nd couple step up on bars 11&12.	
17 -24	1 st couple with right hand, turn 1 st corner, turn partner left hand, with right	
	hand turn 2 nd corner and with left hand, cross to own side and face out.	
25-28	1 st man and 3 rd man turn with left hands while 1 st woman and 3 rd woman turn	
	with right hands one and a half times.	
29 -32	1 st couple, with right hand, turn once round.	
Repeat with a new top couple		

Greencourt Reel 32 bar reel for 3 couple set, by Sue Porter.

1 - 8	1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd couples dance a right shoulder reel of three on the side.

9 - 16 1st and 2nd couples dances right hands across and back with the left hands

25-32 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} and 1^{st} couples dance six hands round and back.

Repeat from new positions

<u>Rannoch Moor</u> 32 bar strathspey for five couple set, from Graded and Social Dances 3 by Roy Goldring

1 - 4	1 st couple, crossing down to begin, dance half a figure of eight round 2 nd
	couple. 1 st finish in the centre between 2 nd and 3 rd couples.

- 9 16 1st couple in promenade hold give right shoulders to 3rd man to dance a reel of three across the dance with 3rd couple. 3rd couple progress to second place. 1st couple finish in the centre.

- 29 32 1st couple, casting up to begin, dance half a figure of eight round fifth couple.

<u>The Pipe Opener</u> 32 bar jig for a 5 couple set, from Graded and Social Dances 3 by Roy Goldring.

1 st and 5 th couples advance and retire on the diagonal.
1 st couple giving right hands, cross and cast off two places. 2 nd and 3 rd couples step up on bars 7 & 8.
3 rd , 1 st and 4 th couples dance six hands round and back.
1 st couple giving left hands, cross and cast off two places. 4 th and 5 th couples step up on bars 19 & 20.
2 nd and 1 st couples advance and retire on the diagonal.
All couples turn partner once round with right hands and then with left hands.
